Stem Cell Advocacy Expands Reach, Gains Two N.J. Colleges

The Frisch School in Paramus and **The College of New Jersey** in Ewing are among nine new chapters of The Student Society for Stem Cell Research (SSSCR), it was announced today. In the past 12 months, SSSCR has produced 57 community activities and more than 100 chapter meetings to promote stem cell research, said its founder Marion J. Riggs. The other new chapters include universities in Illinois, Wayne, South Carolina and Missouri.

Rutgers University is an existing SSSCR chapter; the others include the University of California at Berkeley, Dartmouth College and the Wake Forest Institute of Regenerative Medicine. The society's programs have included guest speakers, for-credit college courses and Christopher Reeve memorial candlelight vigils.
