Granholt, Taubman among stem cell summit keynotes

DETROIT

Michigan Gov. Jennifer Granholt and developer A. Alfred Taubman will give keynote speeches at this fall's World Stem Cell Summit in downtown Detroit.

The Genetics Policy Institute said in a statement Thursday that they will be joined by Sean Morrison, Dr. Thomas Okarma and Robert Klein during the Oct. 4-6 event.

Morrison is director of the Center for Stem Cell Biology at the University of Michigan. Okarma is president and chief executive of Geron Corp. Klein is chairman of the California Institute of Medicine Governing Board, and Taubman is founder and chairman of a medical research institute that bears his name.

The summit is expected to draw 1,200 business, academic and government leaders from 25 countries.
